Photoshop Liquify Filter Project

- 1. Start a new file:
 - a. 5 x 7 OR 7 x 5
 - b. Resolution 150
 - c. Transparent
- 2. Save as **lastname-Liquify** in your Photoshop folder
- 3. Choose a foreground/background color
- 4. Fill background with the foreground or background color
- 5. Render your background using one/two of the following:
 - a. Clouds
 - b. Difference Clouds
 - c. Fibers
 - d. Lens Flare
 - e. Lighting Effects
- 6. Open your people picture
 - a. Select people in the picture no background selected
 - b. Copy/paste to Liquify file
 - c. Place/resize appropriately
 - d. Rename layer
 - e. Duplicate layer
- 7. Liquify picture to your liking using the following tools (on the copy layer):
 - a. Bloat tool
 - b. Pucker tool
 - c. Forward warp tool
 - d. Reconstruct tool
 - e. Twirl clockwise tool
 - f. Mirror tool
 - g. Turbulence tool
- 8. Choose a flower from your Google drive folder
 - a. Cut out just the flower no background
 - b. Copy/paste it to your Liquify picture place/resize as desired
 - c. Add a drop shadow
- 9. Add a colored (not white or black) border at least size 40 to the entire picture

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- 10. Title: add an interesting title format with the following layer styles:
 - a. Bevel
 - b. Stroke
 - c. Drop Shadow
- 11. Save file
- 12. Flatten file and save as lastname-LiquifyFlat.jpg in your Photoshop folder
- 13. Upload **BOTH** files to Google Classroom

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
