Photoshop Using Selection Tools

- 1. Download the file *Sport Selecting.psd* from Google Classroom.
- 2. Save file as **lastname-SportSelecting** in your Photoshop folder on your H: drive
- 3. Using various selection techniques do the following:
 - a. Add all of the items around edges of the document around the center picture
 - b. Items should be selected in the most efficient manner
 - c. Items may be placed anywhere you choose but part of each object must touch the center picture
 - d. **NO** backgrounds from the individual items should be selected
 - e. All items must be part of the background layer should be only **ONE** layer at this point.
 - f. At least one item must be duplicated
 - g. At least three items should be resized
 - h. At least three items should be rotated
- 4. Add the words: Go Aggies! to the green circle
 - a. Change the font
 - b. Change the color
 - c. Change size
 - d. Add two layer styles (ex. stroke, bevel, emboss, etc.)
 - e. Change the shape
- 5. Add your name anywhere close to your collage
 - a. Change the font
 - b. Change the color
 - c. Change the size
 - d. Add two layer styles (ex. stroke, bevel, emboss, etc.)
 - e. Change the shape
- 6. Add a drop shadow **layer style** to at least four (4) of your selected objects remember the item must be on a layer by itself to add a layer style. (Rename each added layer).

- 7. Crop the document so that only the picture you created is shown
- 8. Remove any extra "left over" portions around the edges (eraser tool)
- 9. Add a colorful gradient of your choice to the background layer
 - a. Select the background layer
 - b. Using the magic wand select all of the white background (hint: use the shift key to select all of the background)
 - c. Choose the gradient tool and the color combination you want to use
 - d. Drag your mouse across the picture in any direction
 - e. If you do not like what you see, undo and try again
- 10. Add a border to the entire picture:
 - a. Add a layer at the top
 - b. Select the entire layer (ctrl A)
 - c. Choose: Select, Modify, Border and choose a size for your border
 - d. Choose a color for your border
 - e. Choose: Edit, Fill, Foreground color
- 11. Save again in your H: drive
- 12. Upload your finished file to Google Classroom
